24. LICHFIELD/TUAM STREETS AND INNER CITY TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS

The Committee considered a report from the City Streets Manager, Stephen Matheson, seeking approval to engage the consultants "Common Ground" to prepare a consultation process and concept design work for the Lichfield/Tuam and Colombo Street projects. This was seen to have greater benefits than the normal process of engagement as the Central City Forum, through the Strategy and Resources Committee, had already engaged this firm to prepare a central city strategy and their engagement on this work would provide continuity and co-ordination with the work being done on that strategy.

The report noted the costs for the Lichfield/Tuam Street project would be \$22,500 and would be completed by February 2001.

The Committee **resolved** that Common Ground be engaged to define and deliver an engagement and design strategy for the Lichfield/Tuam Streets projects.
