



17. COMMUNITY ADVOCATE'S UPDATE

17.1 CENTRAL CITY REVITALISATION

The Board noted that the Central City Revitalisation Communication Team had been invited to address the Board's next Seminar Meeting.

17.2 COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

Community consultation has been occurring throughout the months of August and September. Copies of the information were to be forwarded to Board members.

17.3 DISCRETIONARY EXPENDITURE

The Board noted that a balance of \$44,680 remains in its Discretionary Fund for allocation.

17.4 1999/2000 RECREATION OUTCOMES FOR LOCAL COMMUNITY BOARD AREA

The Senior Recreation Adviser, Lesley Symington and the Community Recreation Adviser, Helen Gallagher, provided an illustrated presentation to the Board on 1999/2000 recreation outcomes for the local Community Board area.

17.5 WARD BOUNDARIES

The Board noted the decision of the Spreydon/Heathcote Community Board to reconfirm its previous recommendations to the Council on Ward boundary changes affecting the boundaries between the Hagley Ward and the Heathcote Ward and also noted that when this matter had been referred to the Council, the Council had resolved not to approve the proposed alterations.
