

## 15. NEW BRIGHTON PIER TERMINAL BUILDING CAR PARK - P30 PARKING RESTRICTIONS

The purpose of this report is to recommend the installation of a P30 parking restriction in the New Brighton Pier terminal car park at the intersection of Beresford Street.

The Parks Unit Manager requests that the parking of vehicles in the car park on the southern side of the New Brighton Pier terminal building be restricted to 30 minutes, and that two spaces be provided for holders of mobility cards. This car park, which is located on reserve land, is administered by the Parks Unit and provides for short term off-street car parking for the Pier Library and adjoining facilities.

The Parking Operations Manager is agreeable to the provision of P30 parking and parking spaces for 'Holders of mobility cards' in this car park.

The above report was before the 31 July meeting of the Burwood/Pegasus Community Board. The Board supports the proposed parking restriction.

- Recommendation:**
1. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 30 minutes in the New Brighton Pier Terminal Building car park at the intersection of Beresford Street.
  2. That the first two angle parking spaces located at the northern end of the New Brighton Pier Terminal Building car park at the intersection of Beresford Street, be restricted to 'Holders of mobility cards'.
