16. PROJECT AND DISCRETIONARY FUNDS (2000) APPROVALS

The Board considered various requests from its Committees to allocate monies from its Project and Discretionary Funds.

The Board **resolved** to approve the following grants:

- A grant to a maximum of \$500 to the Deans Avenue Precinct Society for planting on the walkway from Riccarton Road to Brockworth Place. Funded from Community Environment Fund.
- Funding contribution for the Hillary Crescent Reserve of \$12,000. Funded equally, from the Reserves and Green Open Spaces Development Fund and the Discretionary Fund.
- Funding for the Feltex Research Project and ACE (Heritage Award Scheme), in the sums of \$1,000 and \$5,000 respectively. Funded from the Discretionary Fund.
- A grant of \$2,500 to cover administration costs for the Hornby Youth Programmes. Funded from Youth Initiatives Fund.
- A grant of \$400 to T Melind to assist his attendance at the 2000 International Development Pacific Judo Squad Tour to Australia. Funded from Youth Development Scheme.
- A grant of \$2,500 to the organisers of the Westlake Christmas light display for off street parking and other traffic management requirements. Funded from Community Traffic Management Fund.
- Funding of the Harakeke Street angle parking proposal in the sum of \$5,000. Funded from Community Traffic Management Fund.
