11. RICCARTON/WIGRAM WORKS AND TRAFFIC COMMITTEE REPORT OF 25 AUGUST 2000

The Board was in receipt of the outcomes of the Works and Traffic Committee meeting of 25 August 2000.

The main issue discussed was the safety improvement works to be undertaken at the Deans Avenue/Riccarton Road/Riccarton Avenue roundabout.

In discussion, concerns were expressed about the perceived safety benefit for cyclists and pedestrians; members considered that the report and plans (as presented) could not substantiate this.

Also, the ultimate redevelopment of this intersection could not be achieved due, in part, to the absence of any road widening designations.

It was noted that the Council had agreed to release the plan for public consultation.

The Board **decided** to ask, through the City Streets Unit:

- (a) That the Council place appropriate road acquisition designations on the land required for the ultimate reconstruction of the Deans Avenue, Riccarton Road and Riccarton Avenue intersection.
- (b) That the design layout of the intersection demonstrate the required pedestrian and cycle facility/provisions.

Other issues received by the Committee are reported under clause 16, where financial decisions are recorded.
