5. SELWYN STREET - P30 PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to seek the Council's approval for a parking restriction of 30 minutes being installed in Selwyn Street adjacent to the shops located at the intersection of Milton Street.

A request has been received from the shopkeepers to install time restricted parking outside their premises on Selwyn Street (see attached plan). All day parking of vehicles in the vicinity is causing problems for passing vehicles being able to park short term to access these shops. It is noted from the shopkeepers' request that the viability of suburban strip shopping is dependant on short term kerb side parking.

All shopkeepers have agreed to the request and therefore support the proposal. The neighbouring residential property owner also supports the proposal even though the restriction is not outside their property. Vehicles parking longer term outside their property may affect them.

Recommendation:

That the Council approve the parking of vehicles being restricted to a maximum period of 30 minutes on the north eastern side of Selwyn Street commencing at a point 10 metres from its intersection with Milton Street and extending in a south easterly direction for a distance of 35 metres.
