23. MEETING DATES, MEETING PAYMENTS AND REPRESENTATION

23.1 FIXING OF DATE, TIME AND VENUE OF ORDINARY/SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE BOARD

Pursuant to Section 114D (4) (d) of the Local Government Act 1974 the Board adopted its schedule of meetings for the 2002 year. The Board **resolved:**
