The purpose of this report is to seek the approval of the Council for the installation of a Give Way control against Bentley Street at its uncontrolled intersection with Cutts Road.

The situation is that there is some confusion over turning priorities when a vehicle from Cutts Road (a collector road carrying 3,600 vehicles per day) and a vehicle from Bentley Street (a local road carrying approximately 1,300 vehicles per day) wish to turn right at the same time.

The most appropriate way to remove the confusion is to install a Give Way sign against Bentley Street as recommended in the New Zealand Land Transport's manual of regulatory signs and markings.

Recommendation: That a Give Way control be installed against Bentley Street at its intersection with Cutts Road.
