

### 3. CARNAVON STREET – MOBILITY PARK

The purpose of this report is to seek approval for the installation of a mobility park in Carnarvon Street.

The Vestry of St Chad's Church has asked for the renewal of the kerb and channel outside their property in Carnarvon Street. Many of their parishioners are elderly and have found it difficult to get in and out of vehicles when attending activities at the church, because of deep gutters.

An inspection of the kerb and channel in the area showed that the channel is in reasonable condition and it is not due to be renewed within the next five years.

After an on-site discussion with members of the Church Vestry, it was agreed that extra kerb blocks be placed to the north of the church driveway. They also requested that this space be marked as a mobility park.

A mobility park would ensure that there is a parking space available for the elderly or disabled who wish to attend services and activities at St Chad's Church.

**Recommendation:** That the parking of vehicles be restricted at all times to vehicles displaying a Mobility card, on the south west side of Carnarvon Street commencing at a point 49 metres from its intersection with Pages Road and extending in a north westerly direction for a distance of 6 metres.
