

2. MORRISON AVENUE – PROPOSED GIVE WAY

The purpose of this report is to seek approval for a Give Way sign to be installed against Morrison Avenue at its uncontrolled intersection with Sawyers Arms Road.

Background

The situation is that there is some confusion over turning priorities when a vehicle from Sawyers Arms Road (a collector road carrying 5,400 vehicles per day) and a vehicle from Morrison Avenue (a local road carrying approximately 1,000 vehicles per day) wish to turn right at the same time.

The most appropriate way to remove the confusion would be to install a Give Way sign against Morrison Avenue as recommended in the New Zealand Land Transport's manual of regulatory signs and markings.

Recommendation: That a Give Way sign be installed against Morrison Avenue at its intersection with Sawyers Arms Road.
