

1. PAPANUI COMMUNITY WATCH – APPLICATION FOR FUNDS

The purpose of this report is to request funding for the Papanui Community Watch.

Papanui Community Watch Incorporated is a voluntary society whose purpose is to maintain regular patrols in the Papanui/Bishopdale areas. The Society is seeking funding to assist in day to day functions, and has recently been granted \$1,500 from the Fendalton/Waimairi Community Board. The request is for \$1,500 - \$2,000 from this Board to assist in the running of the vehicles. As the costs are ongoing, the Watch has indicated that it will also apply for funds from the Board in the next financial year.

The Board allocated Papanui Community Watch an operating grant of \$1,500 in 1999. The application for funding and letter of endorsement from the New Zealand Police are tabled.

The Board requested a report from Papanui Community Watch outlining where they have patrolled in the last six months.

Recommendation: That Papanui Community Watch be granted \$1,500 from 2001/02 Discretionary Funds for their ongoing vehicle running costs.
