## 13. COMMUNITY BOARD REPRESENTATION AND SUB-COMMITTEES

Board members were provided with an outline of previous committees and sub-committees.

The Board **decided** that the following matters be deferred for consideration by the Board at a special meeting to be arranged to discuss process and committee structures, once community boards' delegated authority is confirmed by Council at its meeting scheduled for 12 December 2001:

- 1. Whether the Board wishes to establish a Community Affairs Committee and, if so, the composition of this Committee and its terms of reference.
- 2. Whether a Community Funding Committee comprised of four Community Board members, at least four public members and a representative of Sport Canterbury/Westland be established to consider funding applications and be given power to act. (It is Council policy that members of Community Funding Committees not be paid).
- 3. Whether all working parties be unpaid.
- 4. Whether the Chairperson of the Board be an ex-officio member of all Board committees, sub-committees and working parties.

## The Board also decided:

- 1. That Mrs Carole Anderton be nominated as a representative of the Board on the Christchurch Beautifying Association Judging Panel.
- That Mr Oscar Alpers be nominated as a representative of the Board on the Port Hills Park Trust Board.
- 3. That Mr Oscar Alpers and Mr Phil Clearwater be nominated as representatives of the Board on the SCAP Committee, until the end of June 2002.
