11. NEW ZEALAND CYCLING CONFERENCE 2001

The Committee **received** a report from Alix Newman, Transport Planner Cycling, on the outcomes of the New Zealand Cycling Conference held in Christchurch in September 2001. The report provided details of the conference, together with feedback and recommendations and noted the key issues that were raised. It also noted that, since the conference, two national level groups had been established and that Transit New Zealand were hosting the first meeting of the National Cycle Facilities Working Party, and Transfund New Zealand were leading a National Cycle Policy Working Group.

The Committee **received** the information and expressed its thanks to the staff and organisers of the conference and congratulated them on its success.
