17. ILAM ROAD/TUIRAU PLACE INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

The purpose of this report is to request that the Council support the installation of a no stopping restriction in Ilam Road at its intersection with Tuirau Place. Ilam Road is a collector road.

Vehicles turning right from Ilam Road into Tuirau Place can have their sight distance of traffic approaching around the bend reduced by parked cars. To prevent this occurring it is proposed to install a no stopping restriction around the inside of the bend on the east side of Ilam Road immediately to the south of Tuirau Place.

A second matter to be addressed is that when vehicles queue to turn right into Tuirau Place and cars are parked opposite Tuirau Place the passage of the southbound traffic on Ilam Road is blocked. The extension of the above no stopping restriction to outside 200 Ilam Road would prevent this occurring.

This proposal has also been supported by the Fendalton/Waimairi Community Board.

Recommendation: That

That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the east side of llam Road commencing at a point 6 metres north of the southern boundary of 196 llam Road and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 69 metres.
