

16. McDougall Avenue/PROPOSED PARKING LIMIT LINES

The purpose of this report is to request that the Council support the installation of parking limit lines on both sides of McDougall Avenue.

Staff from the Merivale shopping centre and the Nurse Maude hospital together with their customers creates a high parking demand in McDougall Avenue for parking spaces. Several requests have been received from residents over recent years for parking limit lines to reduce the incidence of vehicles being parked too close to or partially over vehicle entrances. Parking demand during working hours between Monday and Friday normally occupies 60% to 100% of available parking spaces in McDougall Avenue.

The Parking Enforcement Unit has been consulted and strongly supports the installation of parking limit lines.

The Fendalton/Waimairi Community Board at its meeting on 5 June 2001 also supported the installation of parking limit lines on both sides of McDougall Avenue for its full length.

Recommendation: That parking limit lines be installed at vehicle entrances on both sides of McDougall Avenue commencing at Papanui Road and finishing at Browns Road.
