

16. WORKS AND TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE – REPORT OF 19 JUNE 2001 (CONTINUED)

Further to Clause 4 (Part B) of this report, the following matters were also **resolved** on by the Board.

16.1 Cox Street – Parking Restriction

1. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 120 minutes between 8.30 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. from Monday to Friday on both sides of Cox Street for its full length, a distance of 365 metres.
2. That the P.120 parking restriction be reviewed three months after installation.

16.2 Stirling Street – Proposed Parking Restriction

That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday on the north eastern side of Stirling Street commencing at its intersection with Aikmans Road and extending to its intersection with Office Road.

16.3 Tudor Avenue Proposed Traffic Calming

That the installation of two low profile speed humps in Tudor Avenue as shown on the submitted plan, be approved for construction.
