(b) Community Police Update

Inspector Graeme Cairns reported to the Board on Police matters in Shirley and Papanui. He advised that their patrols have not noticed any problems with overtaking near the Bridge in Kainga. He also stated that they needed to be selective in where they put their resources. He advised that a crackdown on gangs and their associates had just begun in the area.

Councillor Stonhill requested clarification following criticism from Weston Road residents of a Police Officer observing traffic in Weston Road in a marked police car. Inspector Cairns advised that the marked cars have speed tracking equipment installed in them, while the one unmarked police car available to the Papanui Police does not.
