2. ILLEGAL STREET RACING BYLAW

The Traffic and Parking Alteration Bylaw 2001 came into force on 9 July 2001 and currently administrative steps are being taken in conjunction with the Police to arrange for enforcement of the Bylaw in the Hornby area.

Regarding enforcement I recommend that the Council authorise myself to take enforcement action under the Bylaw where I consider that there is sufficient evidence to do so. As I have previously indicated to the Council, I intend to seek injunctions against persons offending against the Bylaw and accordingly any resolution authorising me to commence such litigation would need to also authorise me to make applications for contempt if the terms of those injunctions were breached.

Recommendation: That the Legal Services Manager be authorised to take such enforcement action as he considers appropriate for breaches of the Traffic and Parking Alteration Bylaw 2001 and that he be authorised to make applications for contempt of Court for breaches of any injunctions that may be obtained.

Chairman's Recommendation: That the above recommendation be adopted.
