

## 2. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

### 2.1 COMMUNITY PROBATION SERVICE REDEVELOPMENT, PAGES ROAD

**Bernie Marra**, Christchurch Area Manager and **Gary Nichols**, Property Project Manager of the Community Probation Service, Department of Corrections, were in attendance to speak about the proposed redevelopment of the Service's site at 603 Pages Road in Bexley.

The Service intends to demolish its existing building on the site and erect a co-located Probation Office and Periodic Detention Service. The office will serve the wider east Christchurch community with the staff from the Probation Office in Hampshire Street shifting to the new building.

The building has been designed to blend into a residential area. The proposal involves the purchase of the neighbouring property in order to provide parking for 43 vehicles. Options for access onto the site once the Woolston/Burwood expressway is open are to be discussed with the Council. The Service understands that a notified resource consent process is likely to be required.

The Board **decided** that the information be received.
