

18. COMMUNITY BOARD MEMBER REPRESENTATION ON OUTSIDE ORGANISATIONS

This is a regular feature of the Board's order paper and allows members to report on those outside organisations on which they represent the Board.

As a member of the Templeton Community Hall Working Party, Bob Shearing sought the agreement of the Board to promote various recommendations in respect of this project.

The Council Strategy and Resources Committee have requested a report on this project and this was being prepared by the Project Manager and the Community Advocate.

The Board **resolved** as follows:

1. That the report on the Templeton Community Hall be accepted as a supplementary to Strategy and Resources Committee.
2. That the Community Board recognise the residents of Templeton have for the last ten years had the expectation that a new community facility will be built on the Council owned Kirk Road reserve and that this new building would be substantially funded by the Council.
3. Given the community expectation and the recommendation from the community consultation carried out five years ago, the Community Board recommends to the Council that a new facility be constructed on the Kirk Road Reserve forthwith.
4. That the Community Board support the Templeton Residents Association in their application to Strategy and Resources Committee for the use of the Paparua Fund, along with the interest it has attracted over the past 12 years, to go towards the building of the new Templeton Community Facility.
