9. NORTH EAST BUS SERVICE REVIEW - ADDITIONAL BUS STOPS: ROOKWOOD AVENUE AND BOWER AVENUE

The Assistant Planner (City Streets) informed the Board of the temporary bus stops installed in Rookwood Avenue and Bower Avenue as a result of public requests, arising from the North East Bus Service Review of November 2000. The report also sought the Board's support for these bus stops to be formalised, for consideration by the City Services Committee.

The Board **decided** that new bus stops in the following locations on a collector or arterial road be supported and recommended to the City Services Committee:

- 1. On the west side of Bower Avenue commencing at a point 92 metres from its intersection with Travis Road and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 12 metres (Total Mobility/Orion Substation).
- 2. On the south side of Rookwood Avenue commencing at a point 63 metres from its intersection with Bower Avenue and extending in an easterly direction of 12 metres (67 and 69 Rookwood Avenue).
