

10. PETERBOROUGH STREET ADDITIONAL BUS STOP

The purpose of this report is to seek approval to extend the existing bus stop in Peterborough Street.

The next stage with the relocation of buses from Cathedral Square and improved bus services associated with the bus exchange is the need to extend the existing bus stop terminal in Peterborough Street to accommodate an extra bus. The existing bus stop is located on the south side of Peterborough Street immediately to the east of the Rolleston Avenue intersection. It is proposed to extend this stop further to the east. The area where the bus stop is to be located is presently controlled with parking meters.

This extension has been requested by Environment Canterbury, and has the support of the Parking Operations Manager and the reluctant support of the adjacent property occupier.

Subcommittee

- Recommendation:**
1. That the bus stop on the southern side of Peterborough Street be extended from a point 94 metres measured in an easterly direction from a point opposite the eastern kerblines of Durham Street and extending east for a distance of 18 metres.
 2. That the existing parking restriction in the above described area be deleted.
