10. TUDOR AVENUE – PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING

Details of the proposed traffic calming measures in Tudor Avenue and Waimairi Road were detailed in a report from the Area Engineer.

Subsequent to the Safety Audit approved by the Board in September 1999 it had been identified that, in the interests of traffic safety, a second speed hump should be built midway between the Waimairi Road and Gothic Place intersections, the funding for which was available from the Neighbourhood Improvements Programme.

Reservations were expressed regarding the need for the additional speed hump with some members preferring to focus attention on achieving a lower speed limit for such residential areas. It was **agreed** that an update on progress with the initiative for lower speed limits be provided to a future meeting of the Works and Traffic Safety Committee.

The Board **decided** however, that the publicity plan be approved for distribution.

Note: Mike Wall and Yiyi Ku asked that their vote be recorded against the above decision.
