

9. COMMUNITY ADVOCATE'S UPDATE

9.1 Confirmation of Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board Outcomes/Outputs and Performance Measures

The Board **received** the information and **decided** to confirm the draft outcomes/outputs and performance measures.

9.2 Community Board Meeting with Local Members of Parliament

The Board considered a report of a meeting held on 9 March with Local Members of Parliament and the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board.

The Board **received** the information and **decided** that the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board present a deputation to Environment Canterbury on bus services in the Hagley/Ferrymead wards.

9.3 Community Board meetings with Primary, Intermediate and Secondary School Principals

The Board **received** a report on meetings held with local primary, intermediate and secondary school principals.

9.4 Legislation before Parliament

The Board **received** a brief report on community board involvement in submissions the Council makes to Select Committees considering legislation.

9.5 Heritage Awards

The Board noted the dates that were confirmed for the Heritage Awards launch and presentation.

9.6 Phillipstown Public Toilets

The Board **received** a report giving an update on the proposal to paint the Phillipstown Public Toilets.

9.7 Project Funding Allocation Meeting

The Board considered a report on a project funding debriefing meeting held on 9 March 2001.

The Board **decided** that the Community Advocate be requested to withhold payment of the funds allocated to the Sumner/Redcliffs/Mt Pleasant Youth Initiative until the Board has received a copy of the registered trust deed and is assured that it reflects the statement made in support of the proposal outlined to the Board.

9.8 Discretionary Funding

The Board noted that a total of \$12,530 remains available in the 2000/01 year for allocation.

9.9 Community Response Fund

The Board **received** a report advising that the Community Response Fund Subcommittee had allocated \$1,100 to the Linwood Community Arts Centre, Eastern Inner City Multi-Cultural Festival, and that \$8,900 remained available for allocation.
