#### 9. COMMUNITY ADVOCATE'S UPDATE

# 9.1 Confirmation of Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board Outcomes/Outputs and Performance Measures

The Board **received** the information and **decided** to confirm the draft outcomes/outputs and performance measures.

### 9.2 Community Board Meeting with Local Members of Parliament

The Board considered a report of a meeting held on 9 March with Local Members of Parliament and the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board.

The Board **received** the information and **decided** that the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board present a deputation to Environment Canterbury on bus services in the Hagley/Ferrymead wards.
