11. CORRESPONDENCE

11.1 Bromley Christmas Carols 2001

The Board considered a letter from the Secretary of the Bromley Community Residents' Association, seeking funding from the Board's Discretionary Fund.

The Board **resolved** to provide a grant up to a maximum of \$200 from Discretionary Funding 2001/02 for the Bromley Community Residents' Association to host Christmas Carols for 2001.

The Board also **resolved** to set a guideline by placing an upper limit of \$200 on such requests for 2001.

11.2 Underwriting for Bromley Carnival – December 2000

The Board considered a letter from the Bromley Community Residents' Association advising the Board that it would not need to accept the offer of underwriting of \$1,000 for the Carnival held in December 2000 and thanking the Board for its support.

The Board **resolved** to receive the correspondence and congratulate the organisers of the carnival on a most successful and enjoyable event.

11.3 Kerb and Channel Renewals

The Board considered a letter expressing concern about the condition of the kerb and channel in Glade Avenue. A further letter was also considered expressing similar concerns regarding the kerbs and channel in Carnaryon Street.

The Board **resolved** to receive the correspondence and requested that staff prepare a report on the condition of the kerbs and channels in these two streets.

11.4 Hospital Corner Bus Stop Rationalisation

The Board considered a report from Environment Canterbury providing information about the publicity for the change to the bus stops around the intersections of Riccarton Avenue, Hagley Avenue, Tuam Street and Antigua Street.

The Board **resolved** to receive the information.

11.5 Music Centre of Christchurch

The Board considered a letter from the Centre Manager of the Music Centre of Christchurch seeking funding of \$1,175 to complete protection work for windows in a chapel.

The Board **resolved** to decline this request for funding.

11.6 Sumner Ferrymead Foundation

The Board considered a letter from the Secretary of the Sumner Ferrymead Foundation seeking funding of \$2,000 for the purchase of four second-hand instruments to assist in the formation of the Sumner Ferrymead Silver Band.

The Board **resolved** to provide a grant of \$500 from 2000/2001 Discretionary funding for the purchase of one instrument.

11.7 Eleanor Bodger, Linwood Resource Centre

The Board considered a letter from Eleanor Bodger, formerly of the Linwood Resource Centre, advising the Board of her decision to resign from her position.

The Board **resolved** to receive the correspondence and to thank her for the work she has done at the Linwood Resource Centre.
