## 14. RICCARTON/WIGRAM FINANCE AND POLICY COMMITTEE - REPORT OF 8 MARCH 2001 MEETING

The Board was in receipt of the report of the Finance and Policy Committee meeting of 8 March 2001.

## 1. Funding Requests

Three requests for funding were received.

The Board **resolved** to approve funding for the following purposes, from its 2000/01 Discretionary Fund:

Christmas lights installation \$1,800Riccarton House Community Event \$500

A further allocation of \$2,300 from the Board's Youth Initiatives Fund was made for the legal arts programme.

## 2. 2001/02 Board Objectives

The Board has aligned its Objectives and Performance Indicators with the Council's Community Policy.

## 3. 2001/02 Board Project and Discretionary Fund Allocations

The Council had approved a total of \$390,000 for allocation by Community Boards in the 2001/02 year.

An extensive matrix process had been compiled by the Sockburn Advocacy Team, and endorsed (in principle) by this Committee last November.

Full discussion ensued on the project matrix; one project was deleted, that being the "International Year of the Volunteer 2001".

A recommendation to increase the proposed Works and Traffic Committee vote (from \$30,000) to \$50,000, or \$40,000 was lost.

Acting under delegated power the Finance and Policy Committee **resolved** to allocate its 2001/02 Project and Discretionary Funds as follows:
