

17. WESTERN BUS SERVICE REVIEW – WATERLOO WORKER SERVICE

The Board was in receipt of a report by the City Streets Manager seeking the Board's support for seven new bus stops, on Braeburn Drive and Waterloo Road, as a result of the Western Bus Service Review.

The new 'worker' service route will benefit the large employment catchment in this area.

The Board **resolved**:

1. To advise the Bus Stops and Shelters Subcommittee of the City Services Committee of the Board's support for the installation of five new bus stops in Waterloo Road, at the points described in the report.
2. To approve the installation of new bus stops at the following points on a local road:
 - (a) On the eastern side of Braeburn Drive commencing at a point 58.5 metres from its intersection with Waterloo Road and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 12 metres (Calder Stewart- corner Braeburn Drive and Waterloo Road).
 - (b) On the southern side of Braeburn Drive commencing at a point 274 metres from its intersection with Waterloo Road and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres (Iplex Pipelines).
