



3. MOBILE LIBRARIES REVIEW: STAGE TWO

The Board received a report on Stage Two of the Mobile Libraries review. The Libraries Manager and Outreach and Special Needs Librarian addressed the Board regarding the review of services. It was pointed out that the service was not going to be removed, just some of the stops.

Board members felt that residents of these communities need to be made aware that they may lose this service if it is not better utilised. It was suggested that the mobile library needs a noise to alert residents to its presence, similar to milk trucks.

The Board **decided**:

1. To seek the views of the Kainga Residents' Association regarding the loss of the mobile library stop from their community.
2. That staff provide a report to the May Board meeting with recommendations to the Community Services Committee.
