

## 1. PETITIONS

### **Mary Street Residents**

The residents of Mary Street presented a letter and petition outlining their concerns with traffic in Mary Street and the surrounding neighbourhood. Alison Taylor-Hayhurst and Matt Fitzsimmons spoke to the Board regarding these issues. These include the number of vehicles, the speed of vehicles through the street, the presence of large trucks and buses, and the problems with parking. The Chairperson stated that the trucks are involved in the construction of the Ngaio Marsh retirement complex and requested that the Area Engineer try and address this problem. The Chairperson also pointed out that residents had asked for and received traffic lights, speed humps and parking restrictions in the area. The Chairperson suggested the residents re-establish the East Papanui Residents' Association and perhaps a Neighbourhood Speed Committee.
