3. CORRESPONDENCE

3.1 BUS SERVICE TO WAITIKIRI DRIVE AND ALPINE VIEW

A letter was received from Matthew Noon, Environment Canterbury, regarding a request for the provision of a bus service to the Alpine View rest home and Waitikiri Drive area in Burwood. The Board **decided:**

- 1. That the information be received.
- 2. That a copy of the letter be sent to the resident who requested the bus service.

3.2 CARTER GROUP HERITAGE WEEK 2001

A letter was received from Paul Collins, Marketus Limited, seeking expressions of interest for the Carter Group Heritage Week 2001 programme. The Board **decided** that a Subcommittee be convened of Carole Evans and Alister James to consider two events for inclusion in the programme, including Maori components if possible.

3.3 BOTTLE LAKE FOREST

A letter was received from Robin Rowse regarding his concerns for the spring fed pond area, and the amount of clear felling being carried out in Bottle Lake Forest. The Board **decided:**

- 1. That the Board forward a request to the Parks and Waterways Unit supporting preservation of potential ecological sites within Bottle Lake Forest Park.
- 2. That the Board have discussions with the management of the Selwyn Plantation Board and the Parks and Waterways Unit about plans for tree felling management of the park.
