2. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

2.2 SPEEDING TRAFFIC ON FARNBOROUGH STREET

Chris Astel and Kath Findlay were in attendance to raise concerns about speeding traffic on Farnborough Street and to request traffic calming measures. They presented a petition requesting the installation of speed humps.

Their main concern is the possible danger to children in the area from speeding traffic. Opening Farnborough Street to Winchfield Street appears to have resulted in an increase in traffic and residents consider that the closure of Eureka and Carisbrooke Streets will result in a further increase. The deputation also raised driving on the empty paddocks of the Reserve and the dumping of rubbish as concerns.

The Board **decided** that a report be requested from the City Streets Unit on the petition from residents and options for addressing concerns about speeding traffic on Farnborough Street, including the possibility of road closure.
