**1. RECOMMENDATIONS ON PROPOSED PLAN DESIGNATION
REQUIREMENTS OF TRANSPOWER NEW ZEALAND LTD**

The purpose of this report is to present the recommendation of the City Plan Hearings Committee on the requirements for designations in the Proposed City Plan of Transpower New Zealand Limited.

The recommendation of the Committee relates to five sites that Transpower initially sought to have designated in the Proposed City Plan, although it has now indicated that a designation is no longer required for one of the sites. The recommendation is that the designations be confirmed, subject to conditions. The Council is required to make a recommendation on the designations being sought. The required authority, in this case Transpower, will then make a decision to accept, accept in part, or reject the recommendation of the Council.

Recommendation: That the Council adopt the recommendations of the City Plan Hearings Committee as its recommendation on the requirements for designations of Transpower New Zealand Limited in the Proposed City Plan, pursuant to Clause 9 of the First Schedule of the Resource Management Act 1991.
