

## 10. CORRESPONDENCE

### 10.1 Our Youth, Our Community Charitable Trust

The Board considered a letter from the Administrator of Our Youth Our Community Charitable Trust seeking funding for mileage and external supervision for its youth workers.

The Board **resolved** to receive the correspondence and support the programme for \$1,000 from its discretionary fund 2001/02 and advise Our Youth Our Community Trust of the approximate timetable for project funds for 2002/03.

### 10.2 Linwood Baptist Church – Funding for New Youth Programme

The Board considered a letter from the Accountant/Treasurer of the Linwood Baptist Church seeking funding for a new youth programme.

The Board **resolved** to receive the correspondence and write to the Linwood Baptist Church and advise that the Board will await a report from a Youth Initiatives Facilitator before making any commitments.

### 10.3 Linwood Baptist Church – Funding for Community Programme

The Board considered a letter from the Accountant/Treasurer of the Linwood Baptist Church seeking funding for a new community recreational programme to serve the needs of the adult sector.

The Board **resolved** to receive the correspondence and on this occasion not support this programme as there are similar programmes being funded by the Board in this area.

### 10.4 City to Sumner Community Watch

The Board considered a letter from the Chairman of the City to Sumner Community Watch Patrol seeking funding of \$2,500 to upgrade a patrol car.

The Board **resolved** to receive the correspondence and fund \$1,500 from its discretionary fund 2001/02 for the City to Sumner Community Watch Group.

### 10.5 Sumner/Redcliffs/Mt Pleasant Youth Initiative – (Shoreline Youth Trust)

The Board considered a letter from Hamish Flynn, Youth Coordinator, advising that the Trust has raised other funding and providing a copy of the registered trust deed and Certificate of incorporation and an updated budget.

The Board **resolved** to receive the correspondence and consider this letter further with clause 8.1.

### 10.6 Environment Canterbury

The Board considered a letter from the Director of Regulations, Environment Canterbury providing clarification on the new requirements for boating on the Avon-Heathcote Estuary/Ihutai.

The Board **resolved** to receive the correspondence.
