10. QUEEN ELIZABETH II PARK MEZZANINE FLOOR - OPTIONS FOR CONSIDERATION

The Leisure Manager reported on the available options for the future use of the new mezzanine floor at Queen Elizabeth II Park and recommended that funding provided in years 3 and 4 be brought forward to the current financial year to fund the fitout of this area for the preferred option, a multi-purpose sports training facility.

After considering the report, the Committee concluded that further information was required before it would be in a position to make a recommendation on the proposal. Accordingly, the Committee **decided** to recommend to the Strategy and Resources Committee:

- 1. That further investigation be undertaken into the demand for a high performance sports area in the city.
- 2. That the involvement of the private sector in providing services at Queen Elizabeth II Park be investigated.
- 3. That other sports-related options for the use of this space be investigated.
- 4. That the impact of this option on existing facilities be investigated.
- 5. That a subcommittee of the Parks and Recreation Committee and Strategy and Resources Committee be set up to achieve these investigations.
- 6. That the Parks and Recreation members of the subcommittee be Councillors Graham Condon, Erin Baker, David Buist and Gail Sheriff.

(Note: Councillor Condon requested that his vote against the above recommendation be recorded.
