

1. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

(c) **Graham Reddell, Richmond Community Cottage**

Graham Reddell spoke to the Board on the Richmond Park Property purchase. He stated he was not against the property being purchased but wanted to know why the residents of Medway Street and the Richmond Community Cottage group had not been consulted. He was also concerned that the access way would become a vehicle access way. His third concern was the parking problems in Woodchester Street and Poulton Avenue, and believed this was a higher priority for improvements. He suggested buying a property on Woodchester Street for access might be more useful. He was also concerned that with a park access on Medway Street, there would be an increase in parking problems there. Graham asked what the timeframe for the development was.

Graham also stated that the Richmond Community Cottage would like some planting to take place on the plot on the corner of Stapleton and North Avon Road, the potholes need to be fixed in Medway Street and that Medway Street should be made a Living Street.

The Chairperson requested a report to the Board on the pothole problem in Medway Street and the planting at the corner of Stapleton and North Avon Road.
