(b) Noelene Ware, Kainga Residents' Association

Noelene spoke to the Board on the need for the kitchen to be upgraded at the Kainga Hall. There is currently no hot water cylinder on the premises. Noelene provided quotes for the plumbing and carpentry and requested that the Board provide some funding assistance. The Hall is used quite regularly by Senior Citizens, Canterbury Women's Institute and for Bowls. The community owns the hall, and has some money that is earmarked for the floor resurfacing and hall repainting.

The Chairperson asked if a dishwasher was going to be installed as there were some health regulations that needed to be followed. She also suggested more than one quote be obtained.

The Chairperson advised that there are other funding sources that the Hall Committee could apply to, and that she would provide some information on these to Noelene. She also requested staff to provide a report on the funding request to the next Board meeting.
