6. NEW BRIGHTON ROAD: PEDESTRIAN REFUGE ISLAND

The Area Engineer reported on the proposed installation of a pedestrian refuge island and the introduction of parking restrictions in New Brighton Road at the Kate Sheppard Retirement Village. The Board **decided** to recommend to the City Services Committee that it approve the following parking restrictions:

- 1. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the north side of New Brighton Road commencing at its intersection with Barkers Road and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 55 metres.
- 2. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the south side of New Brighton Road commencing at a point 20 metres from opposite the eastern kerb line of Barkers Road, and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 70 metres.
