21. STREET RACING BYLAW CONTROL

The Committee considered a report providing legal advice on the suggestion for a bylaw to control street racing activities. The matter had previously been considered at the October 2000 meeting of the City Services Committee following a report from the Riccarton/Wigram Community Board regarding street racing activities in the Hornby area. The Committee had resolved that the report on the introduction of a bylaw be referred to the Legal Services Manager for his comments.

The report provided by the Legal Services Manager provided a draft bylaw and legal opinion for consideration by the Committee.

The Committee **decided** that a street racing subcommittee be established consisting of the Chairman and Councillors Ingrid Stonhill, David Buist and Sally Thompson to:

- (a) Consider the ramifications of adopting a bylaw of the type outlined in the report.
- (b) Consider other types of bylaws to regulate street racing activities.
- (c) Consider measures other than bylaws.
- (d) Consult with the Riccarton/Wigram Community Board and other interested Community Boards.
- (e) Approach the Auckland and Manukau City Councils regarding the possibility of a joint approach to the Government.
