

10. COMMUNICATION PLAN WITH THE COMMUNITY FOR 2001

Further to a report from the Community Advocate, the Board **decided**:

1. That the existing/proposed programme of consultation be retained as a means of communication with the community.
2. That the following initial programme for consultation be adopted for 2001:
 - (a) A meeting be held with residents' groups on Thursday 15 March, 7pm.
 - (b) The opportunity to host a meeting with neighbourhood support groups be considered in conjunction with the establishment of the Regional Neighbourhood Support Group Committees.
 - (c) A meeting with the North West Principals Cluster Group (including Boards' of Trustees representatives) be held in early May.
 - (d) It be noted that the meeting with sporting groups will be held as part of the 2001 community funding process.
 - (e) A meeting be held with the representatives of the Police in March.
 - (f) An informal meeting be held with support staff at 4pm on Tuesday 24 April.
 - (g) Business interests – as required.
 - (h) Church Trusts/leaders – as required
