## 20. COMMUNITY ADVOCATE'S UPDATE

The Board received items of information under the Community Advocate's Update and **resolved**:

- 1. To receive the information.
- 2. That the Board consult with the community in August regarding Capital Works through meetings with different sector groups rather than by receiving deputations to a special meeting.
- 3. That all Board members be encouraged to attend the Estuary Seminar on 9 June 2001 and all attending be considered representatives of the Board.
- 4. That the Board:
  - (a) Request that the boardroom be used for office space for staff and fitted out as soon as possible.
  - (b) Request that a temporary boardroom be established at Queen Elizabeth II Park.
  - (c) Host a meeting with the Mayor, Cr Close, Cr Condon, Cr Wright, the City Manager and the Manager of Queen Elizabeth II Park to discuss the future of staff accommodation and the boardroom.
  - (d) Request costings and budget allocation for the relocation of staff into the boardroom and for the accommodation of the Board and staff at Queen Elizabeth II Park in the long-term.
- 5. That the Community Advocate meet urgently with regular users of the current boardroom to inform them of the intended boardroom shift and assist them to find alternative meeting venues.
- 6. That Don Rowlands be asked to present a seminar to all elected members on his recent trip to the United Kingdom.
