

2. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

2.4 BURWOOD ROAD FOOTPATH

Marylyn Morrison was in attendance to raise concerns about the Burwood Road footpath flooding in the rain and forcing pedestrians to walk on the road. She also drew attention to the lack of a bus service for Alpine View Lane/Waitikiri Drive residents.

Marylyn Morrison identified the problem area of the footpath as the section from the Burwood Hospital Limb Centre north. Her concern is that the road is higher than the footpath and the footpath does not drain effectively. She understands that the footpath is unlikely to be upgraded until the subdivision adjacent to the hospital is fully developed.

The City Streets Unit intends to undertake some remedial work under its maintenance budget.

The current bus service turns into Mairehau Road. Marylyn Morrison noted that this leaves a 20-minute walk to Waitikiri Drive in a poorly lit area.

The Board **decided** that Carole Evans and the Community Advocate make representations to Environment Canterbury on extending the bus route to Waitikiri Drive.
