2. THORNYCROFT STREET – INTEGRATION OF UNDERGROUNDING WITH OTHER ASSOCIATED SERVICES AND PLANNED WORK WITH BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

At its meeting 1 May 2001 the Board resolved that the integration of undergrounding with other associated services and planned work(s) in Thornycroft Street along with budget implications be reported to this meeting of the Board.

In response to this request, the Board considered a report from the City Streets Unit's Support Manager Service Delivery.

The report indicated that the only current works proposed and budgeted for in Thornycroft Street were footpaths for resurfacing and Telstra Saturn's cabling programme. There were no cost benefits in bringing forward the kerb and channel replacement and undergrounding to coincide with these works.

An option was to bring Thornycroft Street forward in the kerb and channel renewal programme by way of substitution, and for undergrounding to be achieved on a cost share basis with the residents, if the Council agreed and was prepared to make budget provision for its own share.

The Board **decided** to receive the information and to provide the residents' representative with a copy of the submitted report.

In addition, the Board also **decided** to reaffirm its strong support for the residents' submission to have Thornycroft Street work included in the Council's forward capital works programme.
