

## 2. PETITIONS

### 2.2 Changes to Lower Richmond Hill/Nayland Street West

Marilyn Marshall presented a petition to the Board containing 416 signatures expressing concerns about the consultation process which had taken place about changes to Lower Richmond Hill Road and Nayland Street West and that minor drainage plans are premature until major work on storm-water drains and roading intersections are completed satisfactorily.

The Board **received** the petition. The Board decided to seek a report from the Parks and Waterways Unit on the capacity of the pipeline under Lower Richmond Hill Road and the drain exit at the beach to cope with the recurrence of a flood. The Board decided to seek a report from the City Streets Unit on the traffic effects to the proposed change in Nayland Street and that further public consultation take place as soon as practical on the proposed changes to Nayland Street.
