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## 9. BOARD-FUNDED TRAFFIC IMPROVEMENTS, 2000/01

The Area Engineer (Paul Burden) reported to the Board on the outcome of the consultation process with respect to the three (Board-funded) traffic improvement projects.

In respect of the Piko Crescent and Wales Street projects, the feedback had been positive; these two works were being proposed in order to combat excessive through-traffic speed, and to give higher safety to the high level of pedestrian usage (at both sites).

The Board **agreed** that these two projects should proceed.

The third project involved the installation of a pedestrian island on Peer Street outside Villa Maria College.

The feedback supported the need for greater pedestrian safety. The Road Safety at Schools Coordinating Committee have become involved in this location also. The Committee has secured 2001/02 funding for the installation of traffic signals which is a vastly superior facility.

The Board **agreed** to transfer its allocation of monies, set aside for a traffic island, to City Streets Unit to assist in the cost of installing traffic signals at the Villa Maria site, and that a letterbox drop be undertaken to advise local residents of the change, from the traffic island to traffic signals.
