


7. SANDOWN CRESCENT/CARISBROOKE STREET PEDESTRIAN ACCESSWAY



The Area Engineer informed the Board of progress on the request for the closure of the pedestrian accessway in Sandown Crescent, Aranui. The pedestrian accessway (the land) is held as State housing land and, by virtue of the Housing Restructuring Act 1992, ownership was vested in Housing NZ, although the land is controlled and managed by the Christchurch City Council. However, due to an oversight the land ownership was not vested in the Council at the time of the subdivision. Housing NZ is agreeable to completing this action and is prepared to meet the transfer costs.

The Board **decided:**

1. That the Board ask Housing NZ to take action immediately to close the Sandown Crescent alleyway.
2. That investigations of the benefits and undesirable impacts of alleyways in the Aranui area be included as part of the Aranui Community Renewal Project.
