# 15. FINANCE AND PLANNING COMMITTEE – REPORT OF 16 AND 19 FEBRUARY 2001 (Cont'd)

In addition to Clause 6 (Part B), the Board also resolved:

### 15.1 Project Funding Allocations 2001/02

The Board noted that \$60,000 remained available to the Board for discretionary allocation plus a further \$40,000 for community workers and \$40,000 for SCAP (previously \$30,000).

1. That the Board's project funds for 2001/02 be allocated as follows:
