

1. DEDICATION OF ROAD RESERVE AS ROAD – 68 TEESDALE STREET

The purpose of this report is to obtain the Council’s approval for the legalisation of a road reserve as road.

A request has been received from the adjoining owners to have legal access over a road reserve at 68 Teesdale Street. The property owners are presently carrying out a subdivision and will construct a new road over the land. The City Streets Manager has agreed that the land be legalised as road.

In order for the road reserve to be dedicated as road, it will be necessary for the Council to pass the following resolution:
