

14. AVONSIDE DRIVE

The Committee received a report from Mr Mike Calvert, City Streets Unit, providing an update on the resource consent for the proposed work on Avonside Drive.

The report provided details of the background to the project, subsequent discussions with the Englefield Residents Association and the Environment Court and the changes to the project agreed as a condition of the withdrawal of the appeal by the Englefield Residents Association. The report noted that the work would be tendered when formal confirmation of the changes to the conditions were confirmed by the Environment Court. However, some of the work related to a gabion wall could only be undertaken during the period 1 December to 28 February as a condition of the consent approval.

The Committee **received** the information and **decided**:

1. That a consultant be employed to investigate options for reducing usage of Avonside Drive between Linwood Avenue and Fitzgerald Avenue subject to an appropriate brief for this work being prepared and reported back to the Committee.
2. That a liaison group of two City Streets Unit staff and two Englefield and two Richmond Residents Associations members be formed to regularly review the consultant's progress.
