The purpose of this report is to obtain approval to classify Washington Reserve as a recreation reserve, in accordance with its primary purpose.

Washington Reserve was acquired from New Zealand Rail and was vested in the Council on approval of the title plan on 20 April 1995. Its legal description is Lot 20 DP 68882 (see attached map).

The reserve, which is 7,655m² in area, contains the main skateboard facility of Christchurch. There is also a grassy area at the west end of the reserve, toilet block and associated plantings.

To proceed, it will be necessary for the Council to pass the following resolution:

Resolution

"Pursuant to Clause 16(2A) of the Reserves Act 1977 the Christchurch City Council hereby resolves to classify the land described in the schedule below recreation reserve under Section 17 of the Act.

Schedule

All that parcel of land containing $7,655\text{m}^2$, being Lot 20 on Deposit Plan 68882 being all of the land comprised in CT40A/1176."

Recommendation: That the Council adopt the above resolution.
